Staying Put

Recently I happened to read a very small book, written by the former Archibishop of Canterbury, Rowan Williams. The book, *Candles in the Dark: Faith, Hope and Love in a Time of Pandemic*, has been written during the times of lockdown and is full of insights, also relevant to today's life. When you read it you have the impression of being in front of something which speaks to everyone, at every stage of their life, whenever and wherever they might be. I think this happens because the author is a man rooted in the Truth and precisely this is one of the "proprieties" of truth: it resonates with every human heart.

One of the most beautiful chapters is the one called "Staying put", written on Maundy Thursday, the 9th April 2020. Here some extracts:

Maundy Thursday commemorates the command, the mandatum, given by Jesus: love one another as I have loved you. And perhaps the clue is in those words, "as I have loved you". Jesus, says the Gospel narrative, loves "to the end"; he does not falter or turn away. We know this love, not because Jesus is always telling us how much he feels for us, but in the simple fact that he stays there, for us and with us...

So to obey the new commandment of love is to stay put: to stay with the people God has given us to love, to nurture and be nurtured by, to challenge and be challenged by.

But the truth is that we betray love ultimately not by feelings of impatience or even hostility, but by the desire to be somewhere else with people and circumstances other than the ones actually in front of our noses – by saying to God, in effect, Can we have a nicer and more manageable world, please, with people that it's easier to love?

Of course this doesn't mean we don't seek to change our world for the better; it certainly doesn't mean that we put up with or collude with situations of injustice, violence or abuse. But we always have to begin by engaging with what's actually there, not dreaming of a world where it's all so much simpler.

Jesus shows that he is with us always even to the end of the age by rising from the dead and giving us the gift of his life in the Holy Spirit. And the regular sign of this in the Church's life is the Holy Eucharist.
