The God who notices

Eventually, she decides to ask her husband: "Well then, what do you think? Don't you like the dress, dear?"

Without looking up from his paper, he asks: "What dress, dear?"

"The one I've been wearing for the last three hours," she says. "Of course, you haven't noticed, have you? You used to notice every time I changed a curl, and now you wouldn't notice if my hair was tartan! *And* you've forgotten our anniversary again. The trouble with you is that you just don't notice any more, do you? It really makes me wonder".

Without looking up from his paper, Harold mumbles to himself and begins to wonder too.

When people fail to notice, or no longer have the time, we begin to wonder about the quality of their love. It's difficult to ignore people *and* claim to love them at the same time, which makes *awareness* a very important human virtue, because it is the precondition of love. We can't love people we don't even notice. Love presupposes awareness; it grows in awareness. So too, love heightens our awareness: because we care for people we pay attention to what is going on in their lives.

It is very important for our faith to believe that God actually cares enough to notice what happens to us, that his reaction to events is not: "I don't want to know." In today's first reading we have the ancient revelation of who God is. The story tells of God revealing himself to Moses, and even though Moses must hide his face from God, he hopes that the Lord will not close his eyes to the affliction of his people. The first part of the revelation puts that fear to rest for it shows God to be a God who notices: "I have *seen* the miserable state of my people in Egypt... I am well *aware* of their suffering." God does see what is happening; therefore, there is reason to hope.
