EASTER

† Christ yesterday and today, the beginning and the end, Alpha and Omega, all time belongs to him and all the ages, to Him be glory and power through every age and for ever. Amen.

† By his holy and glorious wounds, may Christ the Lord guard us and protect us. Amen.

† May the light of Christ rising in glory dispel the darkness of our hearts and minds.

Thus the Paschal Candle is inscribed, pierced and lit at the Easter Vigil to become the symbol of light and life for the people of God for another year. We have journeyed with the Lord on the 'Way of the Cross' (*Via crucis*); now we journey with the Lord on the 'Way of Light' (*Via lucis*).

As we celebrated the 40 days of Lent so now we celebrate the Great 50 Days of Eastertide through to the feast of Pentecost. We cannot separate the reality of the Cross from the reality of the Resurrection. In the words of the Easter hymn, 'Had Christ that once was slain, ne'er burst his three-day prison, our faith had been in vain...' In the words of Denis McBride, a Redemptorist Father, 'It is the Resurrection that truly interprets Jesus' death on the Cross.' If death had been the end, he says, Jesus would have been reduced to a 'forgettable footnote in the crowded history of lost causes.' Death is not the end for Jesus nor for us and so we proclaim: Christ the Lord is risen, Alleluia, Alleluia.

The irony is that, while we are very good in our liturgical and devotional observance of the Lenten season, we find it more challenging to express a similar response to the Easter season.

These weeks of Eastertide give us that opportunity to thank God for our redemption in Jesus Christ, to be filled with joy and hope as were the apostles and disciples and to deepen our understanding of the faith and the mission that is ours today. We are the living legacy of those who have preceded us in faith: from Peter and the apostles right through the ages to our families and friends and all those who passed on to us that faith in the Risen Lord.

The fact that we are Easter People should show in our faces, reflecting the joy, the wonder and the hope that we have as a people redeemed, living in the hope of salvation and striving to hand on the faith to others. The poet Edmund Spenser (1552 - 1599) conveys in his sonnet 'Easter' that sense of ardour, commitment and joy that can be ours too. Here is the first part:

Most glorious Lord of life, that on this day
Didst make thy triumph over death and sin;
And having harrowed hell didst bring away
Captivity thus captive, us to win:
This joyous day, dear Lord, with joy begin,
And grant that we for whom thou didest die
Being with thy dear blood cleaned washed from sin,
May live for ever in felicity.

May the mystery of our Redemption in Christ be revealed to us as each day of Easter unfolds and may each one of us be enfolded tenderly in the love and mercy of our Risen Lord.
