THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

Today we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord. Three wise men came to Bethlehem to offer gold, frankincense and myrrh.

It is a story full of symbols that are very familiar to us. First of all there is the star that the wise men follow. Difficult to say what star it was, but surely it was for the men a symbol of something new. For me, the star represents the desires, wishes and expectations that live in our heart. The three men followed their hearts and we have to follow ours. Something will happen if we don't silence what is in our heart. The three kings saw the "star that filled them with delight, and going into the house they saw the child".

The three presents are equally full of mystery. They are symbols of the regality, divinity and humanity of Christ. But first of all they are the sign of the dependence of man on God. The three kings knelt in front of the child; this teaches us that we are not the centre of the universe, we need to obey the Lord if we want to be free and fulfilled.

Diocesan Christmas Crib Offerings 2018

In the Diocese, we alternate our annual Christmas Crib offerings between Friends of the Holy Land and the Knights of the Holy Sepulchre (KHS). The KHS is made up of 30,000 members from 40 countries, lay people and priests who economically support Christians in the Middle East, but who above all, pray for them.

They find many works that support the Christians living in the Holy Land, thus ensuring that they survive and that the Holy Sites are still populated by Christians and do not become museums. The Knights do everything they can to help with practical projects to stabilise Christian communities. The key partner for the KHS in the Holy Land is the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem and through the Patriarchate, they fund-raise to maintain schools, formation, charitable and social activities.

St Swithun Wells Parish will be sending our Christmas Crib offerings to the Diocese for the KHS. If you would like to make a separate donation these can be sent directly to the Diocese of Portsmouth Finance Office marked 'Knights of the Holy Sepulchre'.
