# THIRTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

As we near the end of the Church's year, the liturgy encourages us to think about the four last things: Death, Judgement, Heaven and Hell. Never a pleasant subject to reflect on. November, of course, is also the month of the Holy Souls when we remember and pray for those who have passed away and for those who gave their lives in war.

This year, the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end of the Great War, is a particularly poignant time to remember and pray for the millions slaughtered in what was supposed to be the war to end all wars. And it was fitting that our remembrance of the centenary of the Armistice – at the 11<sup>th</sup> hour on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of the 11<sup>th</sup> month in 1918 should fall last Sunday when we gathered to celebrate Mass.

Our remembrance of those that have gone before us always brings with it feelings of sorrow and loss. But we can take some reassurance and hope in the thought that our deceased sisters and brothers have gone to a better place with our Lord in Heaven. And it is that promise of future glory which should help us in living our faith lives in this world today with all its daily temptations, pressures and stresses.

More than anything, it should be an encouragement for us to continue to be faithful. To be more aware that it is our Christian faith that gives meaning to our lives. A meaning that offers us an answer to the sufferings and difficulty of living in this world and reminds us that our ultimate goal is to be with God in eternal life.

So it is perhaps surprising that since 2011, the average numbers attending Mass in the six churches across our parish has gone down from 1330 in 2011 to 920 today. A sign, perhaps that the temptations and distractions of the material world are drawing people away from the need to stay close to God. We know that in our increasingly selfish and secular society professing our Christian faith can be challenging when most of the people around us often regard us as being strange because we profess a belief. If we are not careful, we can be lead to think we do not need the regular practice of our faith.

It is so important that we continue to develop our relationship with the Lord through prayer and reflecting on his Word. On maintaining the regular practice of attendance at Mass and in coming to understand better the great love that God has for us. To live our lives in this world loving God and in sharing the peace of Christ with our neighbours. And to help in encouraging those around us to be faithful as well as being more willing to share what we believe with those we come into contact with, hard though that might be.

Saying this prayer, specially written for Remembrance services, might help us:

Lord strengthen our hearts, hands and minds, to work together for peace; to see you in one another, and to seek your kingdom above all things; that your will may be seen to be done, and your Kingdom come, through Jesus Christ, the Lord of lords and King of kings.
